Perform with CTC's Professional Company

Audition in late September/early October 2011 to be considered for roles in CTC's professional 2011-2012 Young Audience Series during the school year. For several of our productions during the year, we cast young actors who have completed our Core Conservatory to act alongside our professional actors. These young actors must commit to 3-4 weeks of rehearsals (up to 5 late afternoons or evenings a week) *and* be able to set up independent study contracts with their schools, since our performances are Monday through Saturday mornings. If you'd like to audition, start memorizing a 1-minute long monologue now! **All those who audition must enroll in the two-part Professional Season Auditions Saturday Conservatory on September 24 and October 1.**

London Theatre Tour

Join CTC for its annual tour of London! Stay in a 4-star boutique hotel in London's West End just steps away from the theatres! CTC does all the work of planning, including theatre tickets - you just enjoy the sights! Saturday Conservatory Workshops

CTC's Saturday Conservatory workshops, for Core students who have completed at least one summer Conservatory, are scheduled during the school year. Workshops are on a specific theatre topic. Enroll for those topics that interest you the most - or save money and attend them all! Special Conservatory Master Classes designed for Intermediate and Advanced students are also scheduled during the school year. There's always something more to learn about theatre (plus you'll see your friends from Summer Conservatory, too!).

Intermediate & Advanced Summer Conservatory

The Intermediate and Advanced Programs are a more intense experience and culminate in a weekend Festival of Plays. The auditions are in January, so mark your calendars now and be ready with your memorized monologue! Selection is based on quality of audition, past participation in CTC Conservatories and teacher recommendations, among other factors. *Not all students will qualify for Intermediate Conservatory after a Core Conservatory, and many repeat Core Conservatory a number of times before auditioning for placement in Intermediate Conservatory. Only students who have completed at least one Intermediate Conservatory are eligible for placement in Advanced Conservatory.* **All those who audition must enroll in the two-part Intermediate/Advanced Auditions Saturday Conservatory in January 2012.** For advice on your student's readiness, please email the Education Coordinator at education@ctcinc.org.

Leadership Team

The Leadership Team is a group of students who are part of the Advanced Conservatory program, *PLUS* they assist at Core Conservatory sites, and work as technical crew and front-of-house staff for CTC's professional Summer Rep series. The Leadership Team members must be 14 years old, have completed at least one Advanced Conservatory, submit a written application, and audition for Advanced Conservatory. Once they have successfully completed the leadership program, Team Members may be considered for Associate and Apprentice positions the following summer!
